FEDERAL LABOR STANDARDS REQUIREMENTS for **PUBLIC HOUSING PROGRAMS**

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW: A half-day class on how to administer & enforce Federal labor standards in HUD programs. You will learn:

- Agency & staff responsibilities
- How to determine whether or not Davis-Bacon or HUD-Determined prevailing wage requirements apply to a project
- How to select the appropriate project wage decision & how to apply it
- How to review project payrolls and other documents for effect
- Reporting requirements
- Work classifications, additional classifications, documentation requirements, investigations, wage restitution, and more.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: staff responsible for administering and enforcing Federal labor standards compliance on public housing authority construction and repair projects. Most construction/repair work is subject to prevailing wage requirements. If you are involved with construction & repair work and have not had labor standards training, this workshop is for you!

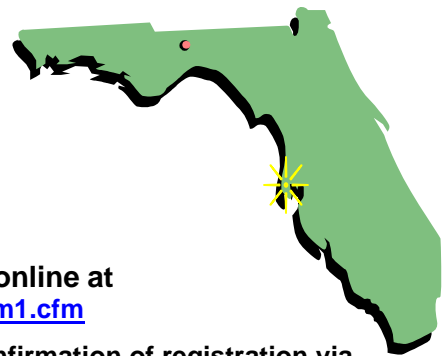
